



## **INFORMATION ON CENTRAL RECORD CARD**

### Ships in which serving

This includes any ship or shore establishment to which the named person served.

### From

These are the dates to and from that the named person served on the above.

### Rating and Discharge

This includes any promotion the named person had and the date and reason for discharge.

### Non - Substantive ( Early CR Cards)

This indicates an increase in pay usually related to promotion.

### Specialist Qualification (later CR Cards)

As stated.

### Badges

These are badges granted, deprived or restored on length of service.

### Character Efficiency & Date

This is regarding the above, for example very good, average, satisfactory and super.

### Time Forfeited and Class for Conduct

Any misconduct and dates of this.

### Personal Description

This is a brief description.

### Marks, Wounds and Scars

As stated.

### Engagements

This is amount of time signed up for.

### Clothing and Bedding Gratuities

Any allowances for bedding and clothing.

### Remarks

Any information other than specific in any other box.

### Examinations

Any examinations passed.

### Class A release

Class A release consisted of individuals released from the forces in priority of age and length of war service, under the plan for re - allocation of manpower during the interim period between VE & VJ day.

### Class B release

Class B releases consisted of individuals specially released for the purposes of transfer into industry for urgent reconstruction work.

### War Gratuity Paid

This is a payment in recognition of war service.
